## Peace begins with a smile, A quitter never wins and a winner never quits

Commonwealth's origin can be traced back to 1930 when the Games were held for the first time in the city of Hamilton, Ontario, Canada and saw the participation of 400 athletes from eleven countries. Reverend Ashley Cooper was the first person to propose the idea of having a Pan-Britannic sporting contest to foster a spirit of goodwill and understanding within the British Empire. In 1928, a key Canadian athlete, Bobby Robinson, was given the task of organizing the first ever Commonwealth Games.

Since then the CWG have enjoyed a smooth innings except for a 12 year hiatus during the World War II, as the Games in 1942 to be held in Montreal were cancelled. Originally having only single competition sports, the 1998 Commonwealth Games at Kuala Lumpur witnessed



a major change when team sports such as cricket, hockey and netball made their first appearance.

In 2001, the three core values of Humanity, Equality and Destiny were adopted as the motto of the Commonwealth Games. These values inspire and connect thousands of people and signify the broad mandate for holding the Games within the Commonwealth.



कॉमनवेल्थ गेम्स की शुरुआत 92 साल पहले हुई थी। इस गेम का पहला आयोजन साल 1930 में कनाडा में हुआ था। उस समय इसे '**ब्रिटिश एम्पायर गेम्स**' के नाम से खेला जाने लगा और साल 1950 तक इसे इसी नाम से पहचान मिली। साल 1950 के बाद इसे '**ब्रिटिश एंपायर एवं कॉमनवेल्थ** खेल' के नाम से शुरू कर दिया और साल 1966 में इसे बदलकर सिर्फ '**कॉमनवेल्थ खेल'** कर दिया। कॉमनवेल्थ गेम्स में हिस्सा लेने वाले देश सिर्फ वही शामिल हैं। जिन देशों पर ब्रिटेन ने अपना राज़ किया था। इस गेम के बारे में सबसे पहले आईडिया ब्रिटिश ऑफिसर 'रिवरेंड एश्ले कूपर' को आया. उन्होंने ब्रिटिश गवर्मेंट को इस सुझाव की पेशकश की और बताया कि जिन देशों में ब्रिटिश हुकूमत थी सिर्फ वही देश इस टूर्नामेंट का हिस्सा लेंगे और उन्हीं देशों में यह गेम आयोजित किया जाएगा। इस गेम से लोगों की भावना बढ़ेगी और ब्रिटिश सरकार के प्रति एक अच्छी भावना व्यक्त की गई। यह आईडिया ब्रिटिश गवर्मेंट को सही लगा और कॉमनवेल्थ गेम्स की शुरुआत की। कॉमनवेल्थ गेम्स बनाने की पीछे की असल वजह लोकतंत्र, मानवाधिकार, साक्षरता, विश्व शांति एवं मुक्त व्यापार को बढ़ावा जो देना था। इस गेम का आयोजन हर 4 साल में होता है लेकिन साल 1942 और 1946 द्वितीय विश्व युद्ध की वजह से गेम का आयोजन नहीं हुआ था।

Consuming the right nutrients is the first step to a healthy lifestyle. A fulfilling diet clubbed with physical activity can help in reducing the chances of chronic disease, achieving a healthy body, and leading an active life. As far as athletes are concerned, making the right food choices becomes all the more necessary because they need more calories compared to an average adult.

Not only is the type of nutrients a significant factor, but the number of times we eat in a day also matters. Now, this depends upon the calories we burn, the kind of workout we follow, and the sport we play. Ideally, athletes should eat two hours before their workout. A nourishing diet can enhance an athlete's performance, make them more efficient, and increase their recovery rate during a match rapidly. The intake they follow should promote muscle growth and repair.

An inadequate diet can hamper their performance and lead to an increased recovery rate. It can also lead to hormone suppression because sports generate a lot of stress hormones, and encourage your body to release energy stores.
